

STATEMENT ON THE SANCTITY OF HUMAN LIFE

Redemption Church affirms the teaching of Scripture that all human life is created by God in His image (Gen. 1:26–27) and thus possesses inherent purpose, dignity and value.

We believe that human life begins at the moment of conception and is of immeasurable worth in all aspects, including babies in the womb, the aged, the physically or mentally challenged, the poor or oppressed, widows and orphans, and every other stage or condition from conception through natural death.

We believe that the Word of God is consistently clear and strong in its support for the exceedingly great value of all human life. Thus, any discussion around infertility, reproductive technology, or end of life choices must ultimately be governed by the principles found in Scripture.

We believe that abortion, euthanasia and medical assistance in dying are violations of the clear teachings of Scripture regarding the value and dignity of human life. We will seek to live and express our faith in a manner consistent with our calling to defend and protect all human life. As with all other sins, those who participate in such practices are offered forgiveness and grace through faith in the atoning work of Jesus Christ (1 John 1:9).
