



## How it Works:

Children participate in a large-group time of worshipping through song, Scripture memory, and receiving teaching from God's Word that is engaging and age-appropriate using the Truth:78 curriculum. Children also break off into small groups to think through and apply God's Word to their lives, pray together, and complete their workbook page for that week. Kids have the opportunity to say their memory verse to a leader on the last Sunday of every month.

## Curriculum

Series Title	Series Focus
<b>In the Beginning...Jesus (Year 1)</b>	Using the theme of mystery and clues, children begin with the death of Jesus and then backtrack through the Bible to discover what happened. They explore redemptive history from the Garden of Eden through to Solomon, then end with a mini-series on Christ!
<b>Faithful to All His Promises (Year 2)</b>	A study on the promises of God, not just learning about the promises but what it means to trust God, seeing how He's been and always will be faithful keep each promise.

## Classroom Expectations

Our four overarching classroom rules are:

- ✓ Respect others and their things (1 Peter 2:11)
- ✓ Obey your leaders (Romans 13:1-2)
- ✓ Participate (Romans 12:11)
- ✓ No complaining (Philippians 2:14)

Children in Grades 2 and 3 are expected to fully and respectfully participate in a structured and organized time including worship, a Bible lesson, memory verse practice, and small group time with discussion and prayer. Children are encouraged to practice listening and self-control that shows respect for others, their things, and their space as a means to honour the Lord and help us make the most of our time together.

Bullying is not tolerated. Behaviour that jeopardizes the safety of others or an environment conducive to love and learning will be responded to in an age-appropriate way to lead children make better choices. Please remind your child of the importance of being considerate of other children in the class and respectful of their leaders.
