



How it Works:

In addition to playtime, children are introduced to an organized time of worship through song and teaching from God's Word that is engaging and age-appropriate using the Truth:78 curriculum. Children also practise a monthly memory verse, learn to apply the central truth to their lives through various activities, and pray together in small groups. Over the course of the year, children pray through the W.I.T.H. acronym (Wow, I'm Sorry, Thanks, and Help) to guide their prayer each week. Kids have the opportunity to say their memory verse to a leader on the last Sunday of every month.

Classroom Expectations

Children in Preschool and JK are transitioning from a more open and flexible playtime to a time that is more structured and organized. We provide lots of opportunity to engage in a variety of activities that are stimulating physically, mentally, and spiritually. Children are expected to be respectful of others, participate, and are encouraged to practice whole body listening during a brief lesson time.

Bullying is not tolerated. Behaviour that jeopardizes the safety of others or an environment conducive to love and learning will be responded to in an age-appropriate way, which may require the child be removed from class for a time until they are able to make better choices. Please remind your child of the importance of being considerate of other children in the class and respectful of their leaders.
